

Who should attend?

- 1. Riders of all ages who are interested in learning about the sport of eventing or advancing their eventing skills.
- 2. Participants must be FHTA members. Dues are \$20 per year and can be paid along with Camp fees (see entry form).
- 3. No eventing experience required! However, riders should be comfortable jumping small jumps, especially if bringing an inexperienced horse. <u>This is not for riders</u> <u>who have *never* jumped.</u>
- 4. Camp will focus on skills needed for each phase of eventing (dressage, cross country riding, stadium jumping), with a focus on competitive skills, rules, etiquette, and horsemanship, as well as what to expect at your first event.

What happens at Camp?

<u>Mounted sessions:</u> Groups (max of 5 riders) of similar experience will participate in 3 mounted sessions, led by experienced instructors. This year, we welcome Dorothy Trap Crowell (dressage), Joachim Englert (stadium jumping), Eliza Farren-Englert (cross country), and Chris Cox (green beans)!

Dorothy is an international competitor who has competed at many top venues around the world. She and her OTTB, Molokia, earned an individual silver at the 1994 FEI WEGs, and a 2nd place finish at their final 4*,at Rolex in 1998.



Joachim and Eliza are trainers in winter residence at Majestic Oaks and so are very familiar with the facility. Eliza has competed at the 4* level and has coached many

riders to top Area and National standings. Joachim is a Grand Prix rider and trainer from Germany and has coached many riders to the Grand Prix level.



We are thrilled to welcome back Chris Cox as our Green Beans instructor! As a Camp instructor regular, she has generously supported FHTA by introducing many Campers to our sport using a progression of fun and creative exercises in each of the eventing phases, personalizing them for each rider/horse team.



<u>Other activities:</u> Friday evening Welcome Social, with pizza, snacks and wine. Our team (along with hosts Marissa and Ron DiMauro) will prepare delicious meals that are a group affair for riders, volunteers and instructors to allow time for socializing and posing questions to our experts and guest speakers. **Guest meal plans available.**

<u>Friday:</u> Check in starts at 3:00pm. Campers will sign waivers and get stall assignments. First Bedding is provided, additional bedding is available for purchase. **Welcome Pizza Party at 5-6pm**.

<u>Saturday:</u> Breakfast in the clubhouse (8-9:30 am) for introduction of instructors and directions to riding areas. **Mounted photo session outside barns at 9:55 am SHARP!** The Group Photo will be sent to our sponsors to show them how much their donations help FHTA provide educational activities.

Riding session I (10-11:30 am). Lunch (12:30-2:00 pm). Riding session II (2:30 -4:00 pm). Catered dinner (6-8 pm).

<u>Sunday:</u> Breakfast (8-9:00 am). Riding session III (9:20-11 am). Lunch (12:00 – 1:30), followed by course walk for opt. mini-HT. We will gather for end-of Camp wrap up and finish by 3pm.

<u>Stalls must be stripped at end of Camp.</u> FHTA members are <u>always</u> considerate guests who leave the barn as clean, or cleaner, than we found it, so we will be asked back again!
