### **Who should attend?**

- Riders who are paid FHTA members (annual dues \$20) of all ages who are interested in learning about eventing or advancing their eventing skills
- Riders should be comfortable jumping small jumps, especially if bringing an inexperienced horse. This camp is not for riders who have *never* jumped!

### **Schedule**

**Mounted sessions:** Groups (max of 5 riders) of similar experience will participate in 3 mounted sessions, led by experienced instructors.

**Friday:** Check in starts at 3:00. Find your stall, sign waiver.

**Saturday:** Individually wrapped breakfast bars, fruit, and drinks will be available from 8 - 9:00 am under the pavilion near the barns, with introduction of instructors and directions to riding areas.
